GETTING TO AYERS ROCK AIRPORT

- You can fly daily from Perth, Sydney, Cairns and Alice Springs direct to Ayers Rock Airport, plus four times a week from Melbourne.
- Ayers Rock Airport is conveniently located just 10Km from Longitude 131°. The airport services both fixed and rotary winged aircraft and receives up to on average 350,000 - 400,000 commercial passengers per year. It is also a popular stopping off point for private pilots and passengers travelling in town aircraft.
