MOSSMAN GORGE CENTRE

The Mossman Gorge Centre is a gateway to the World Heritage-listed Daintree Rainforest. One of Australia's most iconic Aboriginal experiences in Tropical North Queensland is the Ngadiku Dreamtime Walks. Conducted by the local Indigenous people, Ngadiku (Nar-digul) means stories and legends from a long time ago in local Kuku Yalanji language. The walks take visitors on a journey steeped in heritage, culture and tradition.
