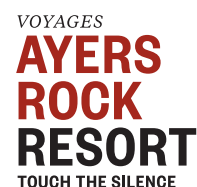

You live, work and train on site for the duration of your traineeship and are supported through a comprehensive residential, social and cultural program. The residential program supports you to participate in the local community, learn life skills and build a solid foundation for your future career. It includes accommodation and a dedicated residential and training team on location.

Upon successful completion of the traineeship you will have achieved a nationally recognised qualification and the opportunity to explore future employment with Voyages Indigenous Tourism Australia as a Retail Assistant or Gardener.
