**WITH A PLETHORA OF WALKING TRACKS INCLUDING A SUSPENSION BRIDGE, YOU CAN SOAK UP THE WONDERS OF THE NATIONAL PARK AT YOUR OWN PACE. TAKE A PICNIC LUNCH TO HAVE BY THE BANKS OF THE MOSSMAN RIVER AND WATCH THE WATER PASS OVER HUGE GRANITE BOULDERS, OR SIT BACK UNDER THE TOWERING CANOPY OF THE RAINFOREST AND LISTEN FOR THE SOUNDS OF OVER 430 SPECIES OF BIRDS.**



## **ENVIRONMENTAL & CULTURAL SUSTAINABILITY**

Mossman Gorge Centre serves as the gateway to Mossman Gorge. Over 20 years ago the Centre was just a dream that Kuku Yalanji elder, Roy Gibson, had for ensuring the sustainability of the pristine environment, his community and his culture. Today, through Roy and the Indigenous Land Corporation (ILC)'s creation of the Mossman Gorge Centre, Roy is able to share his culture and traditions with the public, while creating employment and training opportunities for his community.

Mossman Gorge Centre is proudly staffed by local residents, 90 percent of which are of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage, and all of whom have a breadth of knowledge on the area, its cultural significance and natural wonders.





## DREAMTIME GORGE WALK

To gain a deeper understanding of the ancient flora and fauna of the Daintree Rainforest and the Gorge and its significance to the local traditional owners, join one of the 'must-do' guided Dreamtime Gorge Walks. After warding off bad spirits with a traditional smoking ceremony, your local guide will take you on a journey onto private Kuku Yalanji land along rainforest tracks and past culturally significant sites, traditional bark shelters and meandering cool rainforest streams. Your guide will provide a captivating narrative of the rainforest and their special relationship with this unique tropical environment.
